Bake Shop and Hot Dog Stand: Bakers are needed to drop off baked goods on Friday, March 15. We need folks to run the sales booths for both the Bake Shop and the Hot Dog Stand on Saturday 16

Shop For Free: Help escort some of our ministry partners through the sale as it wraps up, 12:30 – 2p.m.

2024 ABC SALE Donation Guidelines

The ABC Sale is fast approaching and now is the time to clean out your Attics, Basements and Closets and bring us all the good stuff! Please use the following guidelines to determine the appropriate items that will help us have a profitable sale. This year, when considering if an item is suitable for donation, ask yourself this simple question: **Would I give this to a friend?** And if that answer is yes, if possible, put that item in a box or bag along with similar items according to specific department, i.e., men, women, kitchen, linens, etc.

Due to the renovations making way for the new organ, at this year's March 16th ABC Sale, the Parish Hall *will not* be available to house on-site furniture donations, the space regularly dedicated to furniture sales. Other off-site options to reap the benefits of furniture sales are being considered. However, the newly expanded Garden, Patio and Plant Department, to be setup in the Courtyard, will be accepting outdoor furniture pieces for sale.
(Children's books will be accepted)

Other items, such as fine art work, lamps, and oriental rugs, will still be accepted.

The following items, however, will NOT be accepted. Please look over the list for each department carefully.

Tuesday, March 12, 9am-5pm

Wednesday, March 13, 9am-6pm

Thursday, March 14, 9am-2pm

Bakery donations and live plants should be dropped off on Friday, March 15 10am-2pm.

Be sure to label each plant with the name of the plant and your contact information on a popsicle stick
